NORLI'S GUIDING FRAMEWORK

NORLI measures the impact of our programming by assessing for four key outcomes: Civic Understanding, Relationship Building, Collaborative Leadership, and Civic Readiness. Our success in achieving individual and class increases across these four outcomes is determined by fifteen indicators of success. Additionally, NORLI compiles evaluation responses from retreats and sessions throughout the year to achieve a more comprehensive understanding of the class experience, individual growth, and overall efficacy of programming.


CIVIC UNDERSTANDING

MEASURING FOR OUTCOMES

Every NORLI program is evaluated through a retrospective pre-test (RPT). A retrospective pretest is distinguished from the traditional pretest by its relationship to the intervention (or program). That is, a retrospective pretest is a pretest administered post-intervention, asking individuals to recall their behavior prior to an intervention. RPTs have become a standard assessment tool for professional development and leadership development programs across the country, and NORLI's is based upon the RPT developed and utilized by the Cleveland Leadership Center.


COLLABORATIVE LEADERSHIP

Enhancing skills, knowledge, and personal awareness to build coalitions and effect positive change.




CIVIC READINESS
